Ways it can be used

- ◆ Helping participants to get to know each other
- ◆ Expressing feelings and thoughts
- ◆ As cues for communication
- ◆ Exercises in story-telling
- ◆ As metaphors / symbols of states of life
- ◆ Stimuli for conversation
- ◆ Stimuli for self-expressions
- ◆ Expressing one perspective on an issue / theme
- ◆ Prayer
- ◆ Creative writing
- ◆ Raising awareness
- ◆ Expressing faith / belief
- ◆ Talking about one's community
- ◆ Personal and human development
- ◆ Adult guidance
- ◆ Focussing on themes like conflict, power
- ◆ Team building
- ◆ Changing the mood / energy in group

Tips

- ◆ Always use one-third more photographs than the number of participants in the group
- ◆ Place the photos face upwards on the floor leaving room for participants to walk around them. Alternatively, you can hold them face down like a pack of cards for random choice
- ◆ Ask people to move around silently and look at each photo, keeping in mind what the facilitator has asked them to think about
- ◆ When everyone has had a chance to see all the photos invite each person to choose a photo that speaks to her/him
- ◆ If two people choose the same photo they can work out a way to share it

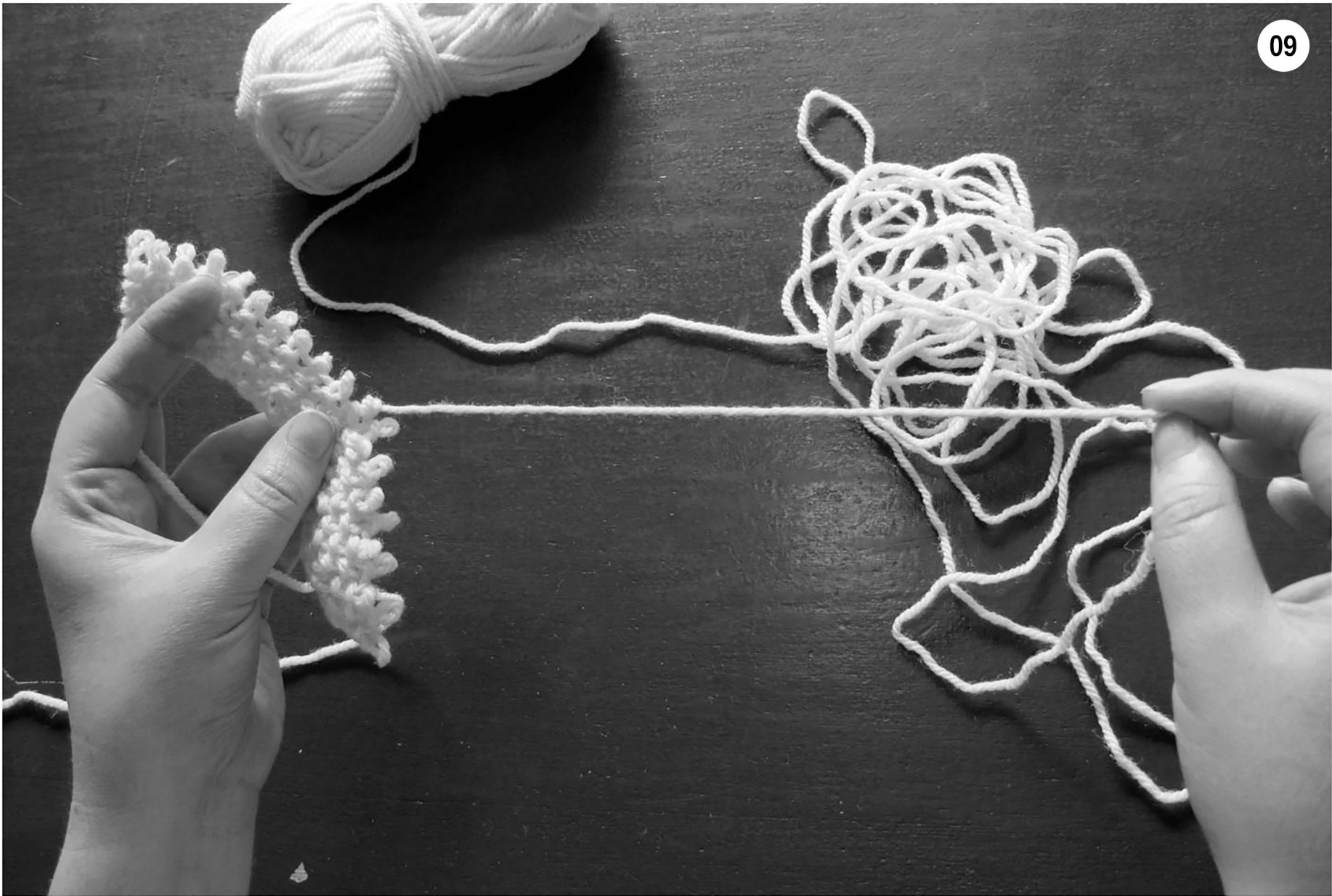

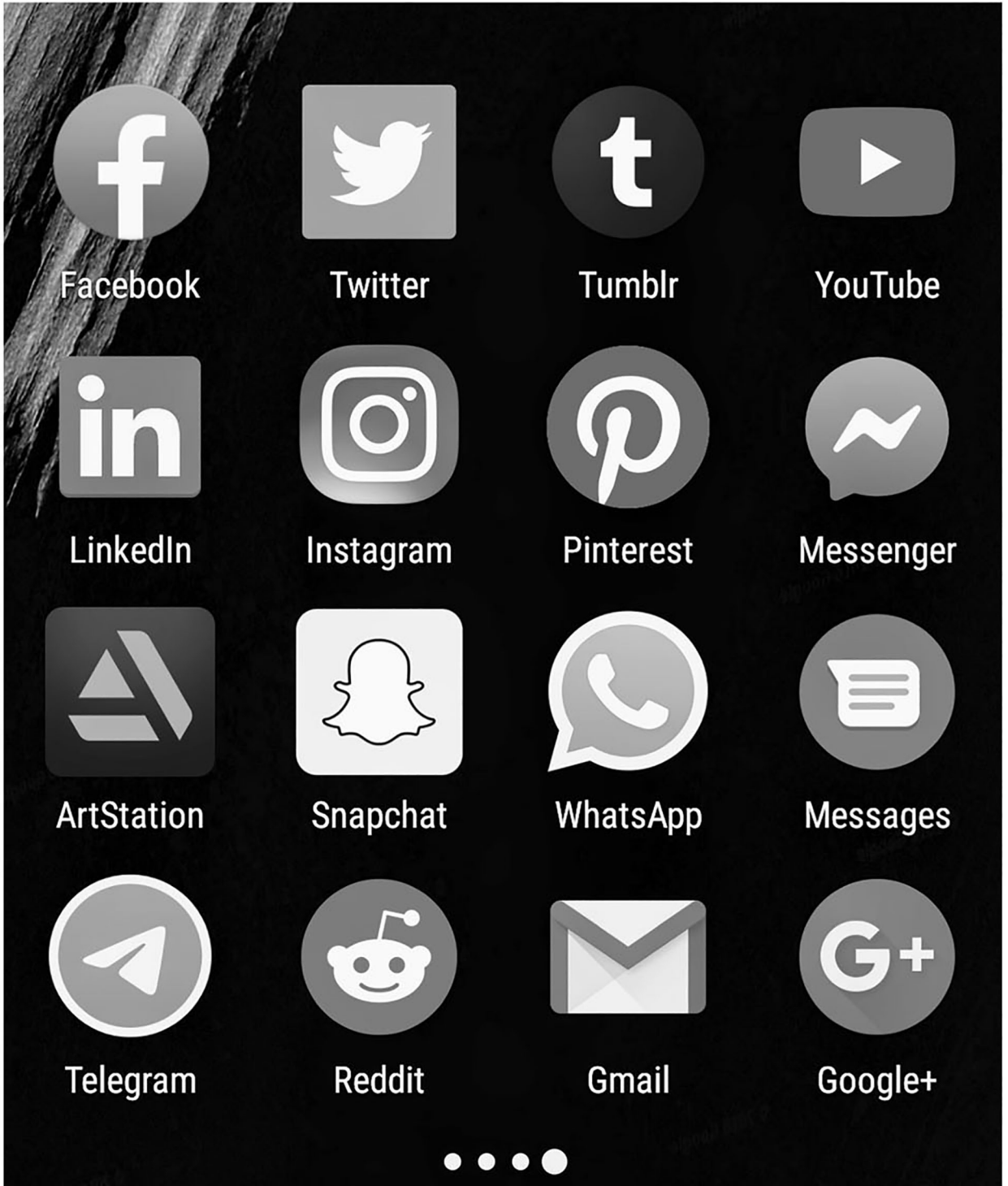




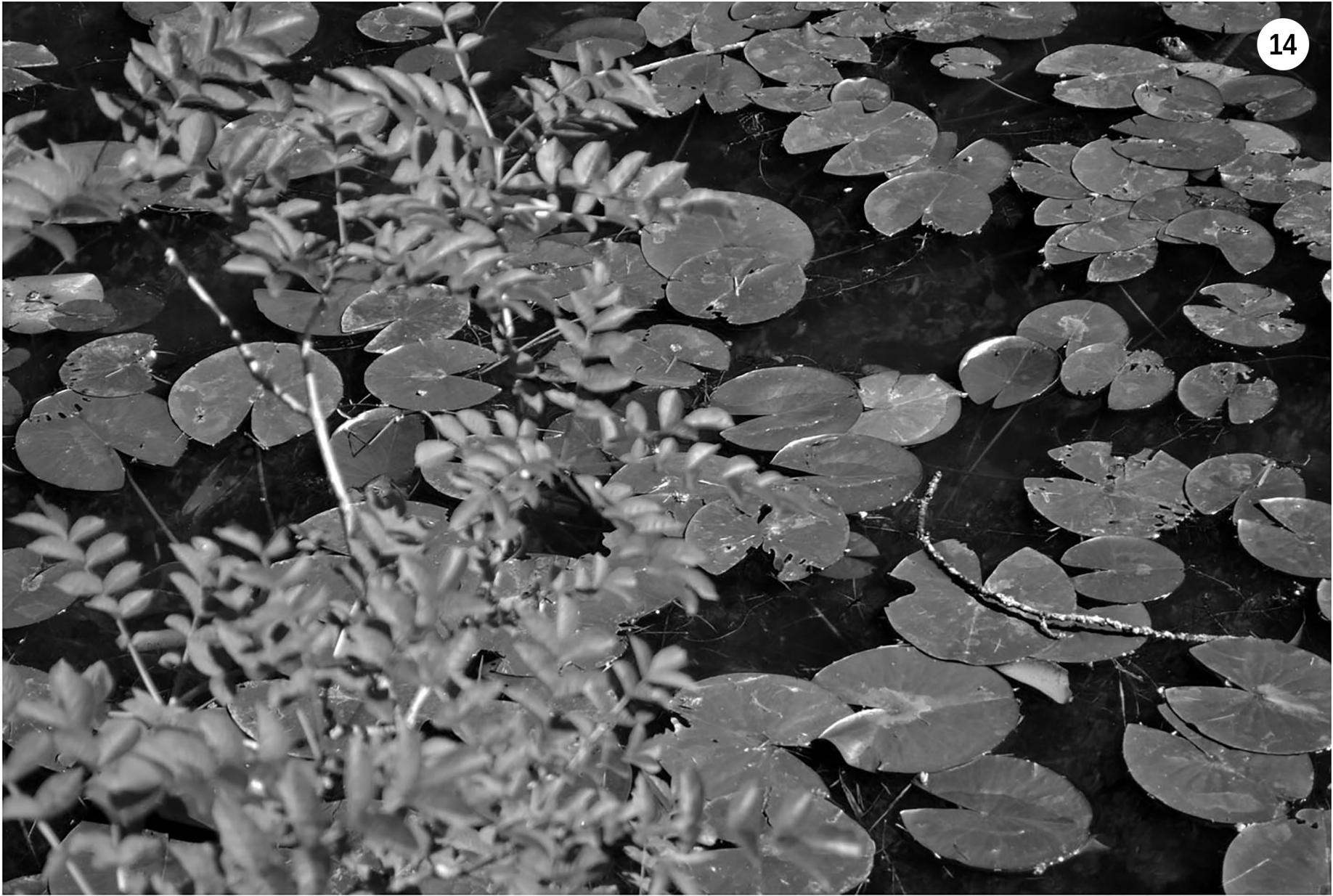
